



The goal of the dinner chapel service is to bring the Gospel message of hope to every man, woman, and child that we serve on a nightly basis. We are doing this through what we now call the 3 “S” ministry – **Song/Scripture/Serve**.

- **Song:** If possible, a church may bring along it’s worship team or choir to provide music both as part of the chapel service and possibly during the meal as background music.
- **Scripture:** Because the main focus of the chapel service is the Gospel presentation, we are asking that someone bring a 15-20 minute message from the Word of God with a challenge for the listener to make a decision in their relationship with Christ (whether that is to accept Him as Savior and Lord, or to grow deeper in their current relationship with Him).
- **Serve:** We are asking churches to bring with them 8-10+ people who will be willing to serve our guests their meal and then mingle and interact with them. Listening and learning their stories. This will also be a great opportunity to do follow-up from the Gospel presentation.

The schedule for the dinner chapel service is:

- 5:30-6:00pm Song & Scripture
- 6:00-6:30pm Serve dinner & mingle with guests

A final ask is that the church might provide the ingredients for the evening meal. Currently we are providing dinner for around 100 people. If this is doable, we are asking that the ingredients be delivered to the mission 1-2 days prior.

We understand that the church may not be able to do all these things at once (or if at all), and that it may take time to rebuild up to being able to provide all elements, but we appreciate whatever you and the church are able to do.
